The actual ACT English test asks 75 questions in 45 minutes.

The actual ACT Reading test asks 40 questions in 35 minutes.



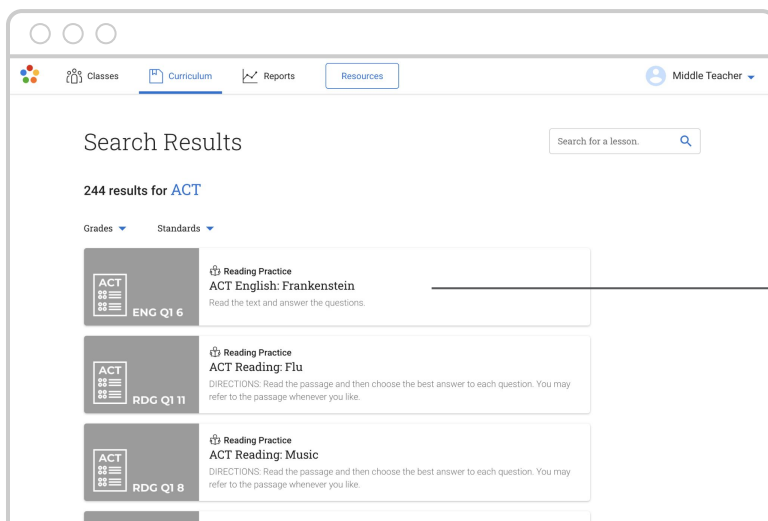
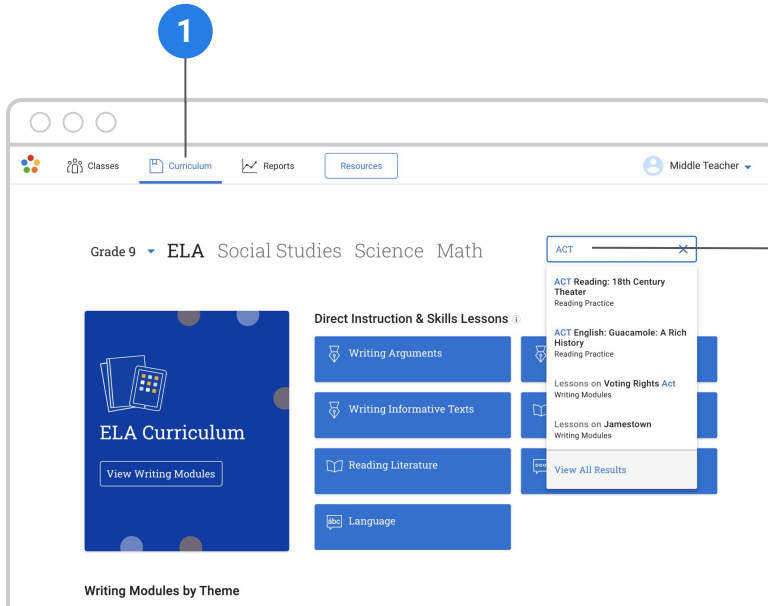
